
CALL TO WORSHIP (Inspired by Isaiah 40)

- One: A voice cries out declaring God's presence. Comfort, O Comfort my people, says God.
- Many: We come preparing the way of the Lord. Together, we actively wait for God's peace.
- **One:** A voice cries out declaring God's equity. Valleys shall be lifted, and Hills be made low.
- Many: We come to make straight in the desert a highway. Together, we're pressing toward God's

peace.

- **One:** A voice cries out declaring steadfastness. Grass withers, flowers fade, but God's word stands forever.
- All: We lift up our voices with strength and good tidings. Together, we carry out God's peace.

LIGHTING OF THE CANDLE OF PEACE -

Waiting for Peace

- Reader One: "They will not hurt or destroy on all my holy mountain, for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea. On that day the root of Jesse shall stand as a signal to the peoples; the nations shall inquire of him, and his dwelling shall be glorious" (Isaiah 11:9-10 NRSV)
- **Reader Two:** We are the followers of that root of Jesse Isaiah spoke of. We are the ones who are now called to stand as a signal to the world, to all of creation, that peace is the will of the one who created us. Peace is the knowledge of the Lord that we proclaim from sea to shining sea.
- Reader One: "In those days John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness of Judea proclaiming. "Repent for the kingdom of heaven has come near." And "bear fruit worthy of repentance" (Matthew 3:1,2, 8 NRSV).

Reader Two: We light these candles, the candle of joyful hope and the candle of proclaimed peace, in part to remind ourselves that we are a people rising toward God's promise. But we also light them as a sign to the world, an announcement there are some who hold on to hope and there are some who work the ways of peace. We stand as a sign that Emmanuel is still our fervent prayer.

(Light the first two Purple candles on the Advent wreath)

PRAYER OF TRANSFORMATION & RECONCILIATION

One: Spirit of God, who dwells within our hearts, Wean it from that which aims to separate us from you. In this moment of collective worship Take the dimness of our souls away.

Many: Let us seek you. Let us find you. Teach us to feel that you are always nigh As we lift up our voices with strength to worship you. Amen.

- One: We come to you, Creator, not asking for an empty or entitled peace; We come to you asking that you call us to the carpet. Remind us to dig deeper to the wells of truth. Help us see beneath the surface level arguments and beyond viral news clips.
- Many: Embolden us to be the revolutionaries you have called us to be so that all injustice might be eradicated and peace that surpasses understanding may reign.
